

# KNOW THE SIGNS OF CARBON MONOXIDE POISONING

HEADACHE

DIZZINESS

SHORTNESS OF BREATH

NAUSEA

UNEXPLAINED FATIGUE

IN EXTREME CASES, CARBON MONOXIDE POISONING CAN CAUSE BRAIN DAMAGE OR DEATH.



**Act Immediately:** Get everyone out of the building and call 911.



If you ever suspect carbon monoxide is present, follow your organization's protocol, or shut off equipment and call emergency services, such as your fire department.



A lot of propane equipment features built-in carbon monoxide detectors, which can power down the equipment if unsafe levels of CO are detected.
